Open Forum: Jeri talked about how lovely the Homecoming Dance was, everyone shared their thoughts on the dance.

The meeting was called to order by President, Sally Villaluz Ghormley at 7:14 P. M.

<u>Minutes:</u> A motion was made by Jeanne Warren and seconded by Claudia Lovegren to approve the Minutes of the September 19, 2019 board meeting. All members agreed.

<u>Treasurer's Finance Report:</u> L.D. Zobrist presented the Treasurer's report. At the Class of '79 reunion over \$800.00 worth of merchandise was sold; a record!

The Homecoming Dance had 127 attendees and shows a loss of \$120.46 in the budget. Sally had a question regarding the discrepancy between the Function Inflow on the spreadsheet of \$2130.00 and the Inflow shown on the Attendees list of \$2580.00. L.D. will look into that and revise as necessary. We did sell over \$300.00 worth of merchandise.

The Homecoming Dance was not listed in the 2019 budget. It will be added to the 2020 Budget that will be prepared before our next meeting which will also include the increased scholarship amount of \$1000.00.

<u>Old Business:</u> Do we need a new Picnic location due to cleanliness issues at Gasworks Park, especially the bathrooms?

- Sally & Mary noted that they did not have time to investigate the potential sites of Discovery Park and Golden Gardens in the last month
- Mike brought up concerns about accessibility and parking
- One advantage of Gasworks is that the city commits to the event in March
- The board agrees that the event should be kept in the city limits
 - o Marysville Historical Park is too far away
 - o Lincoln Park? too far
 - o Is there a venue space in the Arboretum? We need a covered shelter in case of rain or excessive heat
 - o Woodland Park Zoo? Event space is very far from the restrooms
- The board decided to work with the city to see if we can get the bathroom cleaned up prior to the event as part of the \$500.00 fee we pay for the space.

We need to have a blurb written stating that the profits from merchandise sales go to the General Fund and support production of the KUAY, office supplies and events like the Picnic.

Scholarship: All the Scholarship checks except one have been cashed. Kerry will be contacting the recipient. The paperwork is being reviewed for updates to the scholarship application.

<u>Membership:</u> Kathy spent two days updating addresses, phone numbers, etc. in the data base and we are now up to date.

<u>Social Media:</u> There is a lot of positive talk on Social Media about the Homecoming Dance, it was a bit hit! <u>Website:</u> Joe Villarino, class of '79 is coming on board as the Web Master and will work with Don and L.D. for a smooth transition.
