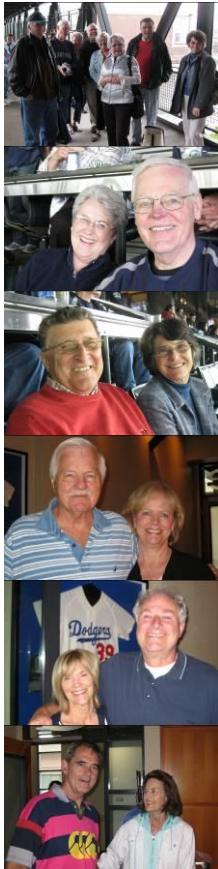

Mariner's Game Day Event Review

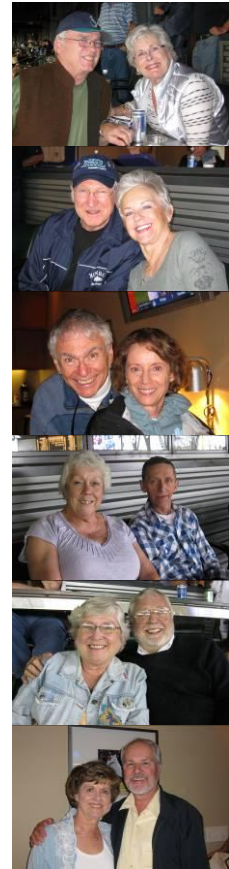
