Orcas Island – Cascade Harbor Inn Reservations - August 18 – 23, 2010

Cascade Harbor Inn is located next to Rosario Resort. We have a block of rooms on hold until June 1st at rates well below the standard summer fare. The blocked rooms are for arrival from Aug 18th to 23rd, for those who want an extended weekend. However, our rate applies to any minimum two-night stay.
