



## They Love the Water

Doug Knight ('52) and Sigrid (Sallie) Knight ('53) met at Queen Anne as many couples have. Together, they enjoyed skiing, and soon Doug became interested in sailing, too. Sigrid's cousin, Bill Buchan, encouraged Doug to join him in competing, and with practice, it was a go.

Their boat was a 23-foot racing keelboat. Success! From 1956 to 1980, together they dominated the sport and won lots of races. Doug estimated at least 1,000 races over 20 years, and they won the 1971 World Championships and the races leading up to the 1980 Olympics. That racing took them all over the world: Germany, Sweden, Spain, Portugal, etc.

"Winning the World was very enjoyable," Doug said. "It was good because we smoked everyone in that one. I don't know how many World Championships I sailed in, but the worst I did was seventh place."

In 1972 they moved to Bainbridge Island where Doug begin building homes and Sigrid worked for Washington State Ferries, which she did for 39 years.

The big one was going to be the 1980s Olympics, but the U.S. boycotted it because of the Soviet Union's invasion of Afghanistan. Doug and Bill had completed all the trials and were ready. Bill tried to get them back together for the 1984 Olympics, but Doug decided he was too old at age 50. But Bill did compete and won Gold!

Doug began a new hobby, hiking in the Olympic Mountains, and Sigrid took up rowing, first in an 8-person shell, and even today in an individual skull. "I feel very fortunate I can still row at this age," Sigrid said. "I've had a few setbacks (injuries) but I fully intend to continue."

Today they live in a condo near the Bainbridge ferry dock where they can still watch the water.
